

## Application for FPCV Garden Plots 2019

Fuller Pond Village maintains a community garden for resident use located at the top of Fuller Pond Road near the entrance. Each year the area is divided into garden plots for residents to grow vegetables and flowers for personal use. Garden plot sizes are configured based on the number of gardeners who apply and whether the resident wants a full size garden or half garden size. We like to keep the garden number to 16 in order to provide a good size space for each gardener. The garden area will be professionally rotor tilled in May. After it is tilled the garden will be measured and marked with each gardeners name. All gardeners will then be contacted and they will be able to begin planting immediately.

Returning gardeners will be given first preference to garden plots and garden plots for new gardeners will be randomly selected on a first come/first served basis. The Garden fee is \$30 for a full garden (approx. 20 X 20) and \$15 for a half garden.

Please review the garden rules before applying for a garden. **Tear off the bottom portion and submit with your CASH payment. Keep the top half for your own reference.**

Return the application in an envelope to FPCV office directly to Sarah, in the door slot, or in our mailbox in front of the clubhouse.

All applications should be submitted by APRIL 25<sup>th</sup> so that we can get started as early as possible.

### Here are the Garden Rules:

- Use of organic fertilizers and other organic soil amendments is encouraged.
- Plan to begin your planting no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Please be sure to weed your garden to ensure a healthy garden and as a courtesy to other gardeners.
- Please clear all abutting walkways.
- All non-organic garden refuse collected in your garden must be removed by you and taken home for disposal. Organic refuse can be carried to a designated collection spot behind the garden and to the right.
- Each gardener should plan to provide her/his own garden tools and materials.
- A wheelbarrow, hoses, some garden tools and a water supply will be provided for your use.
- At the end of the gardening season all stakes, cages, borders, etc. must be removed by each gardener.
